MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Article 1 – Memorandum of Understanding

1.1. This document is an expression of the intent of the Parties only, and nothing herein shall create any legally binding obligations upon either of them, except as to those matters referred to in Article [2] below.

1.2. No obligations on either Party, other than under Article [2] below shall arise unless and until mutually satisfactory.

1.3. The failure of the Parties to reach a satisfactorily legal solution for any potential client shall neither expose either Party to any liability to the other Party nor give to any Party the right to claim damages whatsoever.

Article 2 – Scope

2.1. The Embassy will present on its own website the Legal Firm “Libra Law Firm” as trustworthy and highly specialized in all legal matters in the State of Kuwait and will suggest it for any legal issue should arise in the State of Kuwait to any Italian citizen, individual, company or corporation approaching the Embassy for legal counselling.

2.2. The Legal Firm in exchange will offer pro bono counselling to the Embassy should the need arise for any legal matter in the State of Kuwait, involving the Embassy of Italy in Kuwait.

2.3 Any Italian citizen, individual, company or corporation referred to the Legal Firm for legal counselling or any other kind of legal assistance, will be charged by the Legal Firm according to the price list notified in advance to the potential client.

2.4 The Legal Firm is bound to not share any information to the Embassy staff with regards to any potential client seeking legal counselling.

2.5 Once the Embassy suggests to a potential client the services of the Legal Firm “Libra Law Firm”, the relationship between the client and the legal firm becomes privileged and no other information shall be exchanged if not so agreed with the authorization of the client.
